Introduction

From July 9-24, 2014, Vienna hosted twelve large conferences and 81 workshops which formed the Vienna Summer of Logic (VSL). Together, they attracted more than 2100 logic researchers from all corners of the world.

Over 1700 academic talks were accompanied by a rich program offering panel discussions, an exhibition, and public lectures. The VSL was also the site of the first Olympic Games of Logic and the award ceremony for the prestigious Kurt Gödel Research Prize Fellowships.

The general public and the media showed high interest in the VSL, which proved that logic had once again become a significant part of intellectual life in Austria. Vienna, the city of Kurt Gödel, was reinstated as an important international center for logic research, a status which the city had already held in the 1920s.

A comprehensive public events program was created in order to convey the importance of logic to the general public. Together with public lectures and the very popular series of panel discussions (LogicLounge), an exhibition called "Kurt Gödel and the Origins of Logic in Vienna" provided a multi-faceted experience of logic research and history.

The first Olympic Games of Logic established a new academic tradition: from now on, this cluster of solver competitions will be held every four years as part of the Federated Logic Conference, gathering challenging disciplines from the field of computational logic.

The impact of the VSL speaks of great success: Not only was the Vienna Summer of Logic an exceptionally large academic gathering in computer science, it directed a significant amount of public attention to logic research as well.

Zwischen dem 9. und 24. Juli 2014 lockten die zwölf großen Konferenzen und 81 Workshops des Vienna Summer of Logic (VSL) über 2100 Logik-ForscherInnen aus der ganzen Welt nach Wien.

Mehr als 1700 wissenschaftliche Vorträge wurden durch Podiumsdiskussionen, eine Ausstellung und Vorlesungen für die interessierte Öffentlichkeit begleitet. Die ersten „Olympischen Spiele der Logik“ sowie die Verleihung der hochdotierten „Kurt Gödel Research Prize Fellowships“ wurden im Rahmen des VSL abgehalten.

Das große öffentliche Interesse und die Medienresonanz beweisen: Logik ist heute wieder ein wesentlicher Teil des intellektuellen Lebens in Österreich. Wien, die Stadt Kurt Gödels, ist wieder ein wichtiges internationales Zentrum dieses Forschungsgebietes, wie sie das schon in den 1920er Jahren war.

Um einer breiten Öffentlichkeit zu vermitteln, wie wichtig Logik heute ist, wurde ein umfangreiches Öffentlichkeitsprogramm zusammengestellt. Neben Public Lectures und einer vielbesuchten Reihe an Podiumsdiskussionen (LogicLounge) gab es auch eine Ausstellung über Kurt Gödel und die Ursprünge der Logik in Wien zu sehen.

Mit den Olympischen Spielen der Logik wurde eine neue wissenschaftliche Tradition begründet: In Zukunft soll dieser Wettbewerb, bei dem in zahlreichen Kategorien Logik-Programme gegeneinander antreten, alle vier Jahre im Rahmen der Federated Logic Conference abgehalten werden.

Die erfolgreiche Bilanz der größten Veranstaltung in der Geschichte der Logik: Der Vienna Summer of Logic war nicht nur ein wissenschaftliches Großereignis, er trug auch dazu bei, der Logikforschung breite öffentliche Aufmerksamkeit zu verschaffen.

Music during the Vienna Summer of Logic

During the first VSL Joint Award Ceremony, the attendees were able to witness the world premiere of the *Tribute to Kurt Gödel* (op. 55) and to listen to a short musical piece called *Gödel Fanfare*, both composed by Michael F.P. Huber.

Michael F.P. Huber is an Austrian composer living in Innsbruck. He studied musicology and composition at the University of Music and Performing Arts in Vienna under Iván Erőd, Kurt Schwertsik, Klaus-Peter Sattler and Christian Mühlbacher.

The music pieces were performed by the Adamas string quartet, formed by Claudia Schwarzl (violin), Roland Herret (violin), Anna Dekan (viola) and Jakob Gisler (violoncello). The Adamas string quartet is a leading young quartet in Vienna and regularly performs in concerts worldwide. The artists have been honored with prizes and awards in many competitions and are open to unconventional ideas and projects such as this tribute to Kurt Gödel.

Vienna Summer of Logic Visual Identity

The laurel wreath in the logo of the Vienna Summer of Logic is taken from an architectural detail on the side elevation of the Secession building not far from the conference site. Designed by Koloman Moser, it appears there in conjunction with three owls, attributes of Athena, the Greek goddess of wisdom. It is intended to connect the Vienna Summer of Logic back to ancient Greece, where logic as an independent field of study was initiated. As laurel wreaths were awarded to victors of athletic competitions in ancient times, the logo also references the Olympic tradition, continued in spirit at the FLoC Olympic Games of competitions in fields of computational logic. The reference to art of the Secession Movement also connects the Vienna Summer of Logic to the times of Gödel, Wittgenstein, and the Vienna Circle.

Like the Vienna Circle movement did in science and philosophy, the Vienna Secessionist Movement objected to the prevailing conservatism of its time and gained international fame. By a beautiful coincidence of history, the Secession Movement had its first address in the former Hotel Victoria which today houses the Department of Computer Science of the Vienna University of Technology.



The conference poster is a playful reply to the frequent association of VSL with the Summer of Love. Designed as an art festival poster, it expresses our passion for logic and the enthusiasm for the intellectual feast ahead.


